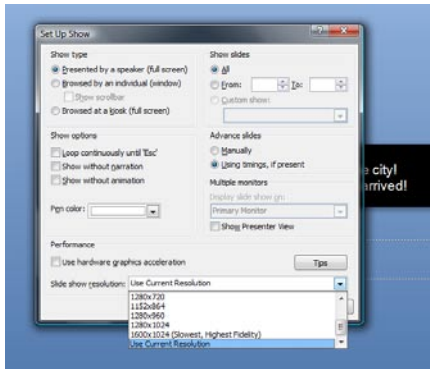

## Frequently Asked Questions



### How do I change the size of the presentation?

You can change the presentation size on most projectors (aspect ratio, even by turning the lens itself). You can also change the resolution within Powerpoint, in the slide show's settings. See the screen shot at left for what this dialog box might look like.

### What should I do if the slides get out of order?

If you are using the recommended Presenter View, you should be able to double click on the slide in question to insert it into the slide show. Some Powerpoint versions have a "Black Screen" button in Presenter View as well. If all else fails, a piece of cardboard placed in front of the projector always does the trick!

### We have a very old version of Powerpoint. What's the minimum version required?

It is recommended to use at least Powerpoint 2003, but 2000 will likely work. Anything older than 2000 should probably not be used. If necessary, a special edition of your cut version can be created for you that will not require Powerpoint.

### Our screen is much more narrow than the 1x8 ratio for which your slides are designed.

The slides can be altered, but it is not recommended you add slides without consulting with me for tips on how to do it. I'm also happy to help you with this problem, so don't panic – call or email for assistance and I will make sure your slides look fantastic.

### Where should I return the marked score?

Return the marked score, clean of all markings and cut indications, to:
